

The European RoHS-Directive 2011/65/EU (Restriction of Hazardous Substances) restricts the content of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. Restriction is aimed at ensuring the necessary level of protection to both human health and environment by supporting the choice of safer products and also promoting the economic profitability of recycling.

The steel products used in the production of electrical and electronic equipment must not exceed a maximum content of 0.1% in weight of lead, chromium VI, mercury, polybrominated biphenyls, polybrominated diphenyl ethers and 0.01% in weight of cadmium.

The steel products we supply such as Hot Rolled (Dry and Pickled & Oiled), Cold Rolled, Hot Dipped Galvanized, Electro Zinc Coated and Aluminized do not exceed the permitted levels and therefore comply with the RoHS-Directive. Furthermore the anti-corrosive surface treatments of our coated products do not contain any chromium VI.
